### **SEE ANSWERS TO QUESTION BELOW:**

Q1: The bid bond form that was provided in the bid package lists Town of Lunenburg as Owner (see attached), please provide an updated form that lists Town of Granville as Owner.

A: See attached updated Bid Bond Form.

Q2: Will you accept an A310-2010 bid bond form? Or should we use the same format as is included in the bid?

A: Please use attached Bid Bond Form.

Q3: Will there be a pre-bid meeting on site?

A: There is no pre-bid meeting for this project.

Q4: Item # 628.24 is a MassDOT Item Number for transition to bridge rail, which includes 1 each double nested thrie beam panel 12'6" long, 1 each thrie beam transition panel 6.5 ft long and 1 each w beam panel 12'6" long.

The Drawings for the first 2 bridges, Item Number 975 is for the bridge railing, which we would need to use W beam panels that actually go over the bridge railing on the bridge, off the bridge it shows on Drawing Sheet 29-30 of bridge plans/drawings that there is no thrie beam guardrail, so the 628.24 Item Number does not match these old connections to bridge rail as they are not mash compliant. The third bridge shows the thrie beam bridge rail on bridge then off the bridge on Page 10 of the bridge railing details Item 628.25 thrie beam transition which is the 6'3" panel that takes you from the

# big panel to the small panel off the bridge so Item 628.24 is still not used even on this one as all guardrail off the bridges show in the dirt show smaller W beam guardrail not thrie beam.

A: Item No. 628.24 is not intended to be the standard MassDOT Transition to Bridge Rail Item. We have revised Item No. 628.24 to be 628.2411 to clarify. Item No. 628.2411 is intended to be the Railing Transition shown on Sheet 21 of 30 and 30 of 30 of the Beech Hill Rd and Borden Brook Rd Plans. Item 628.24 is not used on the third bridge, G-10-013. The bridge railing and guardrail approach transitions shall be as shown on the G-10-013 plans.

Q3: We have a question regarding the insurance requirements. In Article 22 of the Instructions to bidders (page 11 of 449) it states "The following types of insurance shall be provided by the Contractor". However in the General Conditions, Para 6.04 it mentions Builder's Risk and Other Property Insurance" (not mentioned in Article 22). We assume as this is a site contract and there is no "building" we will NOT be needing Builder's Risk? Please confirm the only insurance needed is what is stated in Article 22.

A: Builder's Risk is not required. Only the insurance stated in Article 22 is required.

# Q4: Please specify which items to be removed are paid under 127 Concrete Excavation vs Item 127.1 Reinforced Concrete Excavation

A: Estimated quantities for each of these items are provided on the bid tab form. For G-10-028 and G-10-039, it is assumed that the concrete arches and curbs are reinforced concrete. It is assumed that the abutments and wingwalls are unreinforced concrete.

### Q5: Specs state that all shielding and SOE are part of 127 and 127.1.

A: Confirmed for Bridges G-10-028 and G-10-039. Item No 994.01 is for temporary protective shielding at Bridge No. G-10-013.

#### Q6: Are existing bridge plans available for these locations?

A: No existing plans are available for the bridges G-10-028 and G-10-039. Existing bridge plans for G-10-013 are included in this addendum.

#### Q7: Will in water work be allowed to provide supports at the required locations?

A: Supports are not permitted within the waterways. Please see the Notice of Intent submitted for these bridges and the Order of Conditions from the Conservation Commission included in the bid package.

# Q8: Is a temporary bypass plan required when working within the brook?

A: A temporary bypass for the brook is not anticipated to be needed. Please see the Notice of Intent submitted for these bridges and the Order of Conditions from the Conservation Commission included in the bid package.

# Q9: Are existing bridge plans available for use in the demolition takeoff?

A: No existing plans are available for the bridges G-10-028 and G-10-039. Existing bridge plans for G-10-013 are included in this addendum.

## Q10: Please confirm that Item 127.12 is to be paid by the SY.

A: Confirmed, Item 127.12 is intended to be paid by the SY.

Q11: At which bridges is it intended to leave traffic open during the work? Removing the arch headwalls with unknown bridge conditions may result in additional supports/demo to be required. Additionally, there is not enough room to allow for 1 lane traffic plus a work area where bridge arches are proposed to be replaced.

A: All bridges are anticipated to be closed for the duration of the work.

# Q12: Please provide bid tabulations for this project

A: Bid tabulation form is provided in Section 3 of the bid package.

# Q13: Please provide supplementary conditions.

A: Any supplementary conditions to the General Conditions in the EJCDC Document are listed in the Instructions for Bidders and the Agreement.
