- Installation of ±350 LF steel sheet pile bulkhead w/soil anchors located 20' landward of existing bulkhead; includes oversheeting of existing timber bulkhead (adjacent to existing offloading pier) and extension along Rock Harbor Rd/Bay View Dr. to replace existing shoreline protection;
- Installation of new ±6,950 SF steel pipe pile supported concrete commercial off-loading and public viewing deck (combination of pre-cast and CIP concrete);
- Installation of new 1-ton jib crane.
- Reconstruction of timber Town Pier (north limit of project);
- Installation of new timber landing pier with dual gangway access to new North and South commercial docks;
- Installation of timber berthing piles;
- Installation of drainage, water, and electrical systems;
- Removal of existing USTs and associated fuel dispensers and underground lines;
- Installation of new fuel dispensers and underground lines connecting into new ASTs; and
