**Kinetic Demolition & Engineering, LLC email dated April 12, 2024:**

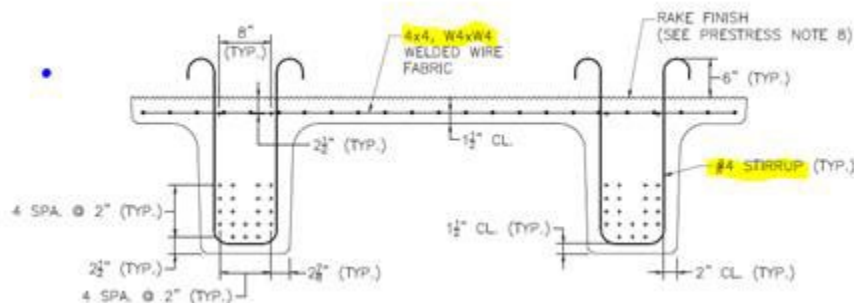
**Question #1:** Are there any existing plans, inspection reports, or rating reports available for the existing structure?

**Response #1:** The inspection reports and bridge rating reports have been provided. Bridge M-28-026 is a municipally owned structure, the Town of Montague may be contacted for any existing bridge plans.

**United Concrete Products, Inc. email dated April 16, 2024:**

**Question #2:** Can we change the 4x4 W4xW4 WWF in the NEXT Beams to rebar with an equivalent steel area? The #4 stirrups that come up through do not fit through the 4x4 spacing.

Below is the detail for reference.



**Response #2:** Mild steel reinforcing bars may be used in place of welded wire reinforcement provided an equivalent area of steel is maintained and the bar spacing does not exceed 12”.
