Addendum Number One. Prospective bidders, and those concerned, are hereby informed that the following is made a part of the bid documents, which should be amended as below.

- Replace Bid Proposal in entirety with attached Bid Proposal (16 pages) and use attached bid proposal for submission of bids.

Responses to requests for information and clarifications:

1. On drawing LP.2 it states that the lights are to be provided by Darien. Are these installed as part of this contract as there is no items for this?
 - **Lights to be provided and installed by the Town.**
2. Bid Alternate #2 – On Drawing SE-3 it calls for 715' of 3" PVC.

ADD ALT #2: INSTALL 715± LF OF (2) - 3" PVC COMMUNICATION CONDUITS

 This bid item is for only 2" conduit. Will the item be revised to be 3" conduit instead?
 - **All underground conduits shall be 2" diameter.**
3. Bid Alternate #2 – Please provide size of communication quazite box required. Is the 17" x 30" as shown on the drawing the same for all boxes?
 - **Yes.**
4. Is all electrical conduit to be Schedule 40 or Schedule 80 PVC?
 - **Electrical conduits to be Schedule 40.**
5. Item #36 – This calls out 1780' of 2 – 2" PVC. When I do the takeoff, it comes out to about half (890') that on drawing SE-3. Should this item be 1,780' of 2" PVC or 890' of 2 – 2" PVC?
 - **Use 890 LF for Bid Item No. 36 (revised).**
6. Item #37 – Please provide specifications for lighting panel (amperage, voltage, poles, mounting to, one line diagram) as there is no design to it. We would need wire size, conduit size, etc.
 - **(1) 100 amp Meter Panel (Approx. 12'x24") 120v**
 - **(1) Light Control Panel (Approx. 12'x24")**

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- Emergency Shut off
 - Timer
 - Photo Cell
 - Both panels shall be mounted in close proximity to the transformer on (2) 1 ¾" Square Sign posts with (2) cross braces properly installed 18" deep with concrete around posts.
 - Wire size is #10 with 2" conduits
7. Item #38 – Please provide specification on existing transformer that we are connecting to (size, are lugs required, where is this feed from, one line diagram).
- 50 kva Transformer – Single Phase.
 - Feed to transformer underground from intersection of Goodwives River Rd and Rings End Rd.
 - Lugs Required.
8. Item #39 – Please provide length of site light base both below grade and above grade. Cut sheet only provide generic information.
- 42" total length (6" above grade & 36" below grade)
9. What pay item will be used to replace the unsuitable fill excavated below the proposed concrete retaining wall? Will the processed aggregate item be used? Will a new item be added, or should we include the replacement material in the excavation item?
- Yes, process aggregate item to be used for replacement soil. Use 1700 CY for Bid Item No. 6 (revised).
10. Regarding police and flagging, is this the correct interpretation? When police are available, they are hired by the contractor and paid for by the Town, when the police are unavailable the contractor will hire and pay for the flagger, and this cost should be included in the Maintenance and Protection lump sum item.

- 1.01 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with the Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

- 2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Advertisement or Invitation to Bid and Instruction to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. The Bid will remain subject to acceptance for Ninety (90) days after the Bid opening.
- 2.02 The Town reserves the right to add or delete work to meet budget constraints or other issues that may benefit the town.
- 2.03 The Town reserves the right to reject all bids in whole or in part and to waive technical defects, irregularities and omissions if the best interests of the Town are served. The Town reserves the right to reject any bid associated with a contractor who currently has any form of legal action pending against the Town.
- 2.04 The Town of Darien reserves the right to require a bidder to furnish satisfactory evidence of his ability to furnish the materials and work upon which his bid is based. All work shall be done by experienced qualified personnel. Any work not in accordance with these specifications shall be corrected at the Contractor's expense.
- 2.05 The Contractor shall not sublet, sell, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of the work, or any portion thereof, or of his right, title or interest therein, to any person without written approval of the Town.
- 2.06 A copy of the bidders Certificate of Insurance covering limits as set for these specifications are required. Failure of any bidder to supply these documents within the time frame indicated as part of the Notice of Award may result in the disqualification of his bid.
- 2.07 The Contractor must agree to comply with the requirements of State of Connecticut Executive Order No. 3 promulgated to promote equal employment opportunity and non-discrimination throughout the labor force in Connecticut.

- 2.08 All bidders should familiarize themselves with the present condition of the access driveway property by a personal inspection.

- 3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents, as set forth in the Agreement, that:
- A) Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of all which is hereby acknowledged:

- B) Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C) Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.
- D) Bidder has carefully studied all available reports and drawings, if any regarding subsurface or environmentally hazardous conditions.
- E) Bidder assumes responsibility for having obtained all necessary data relative to site conditions which will affect cost, progress, performance, means, methods, safety, sequencing, techniques, procedures, etcetera, incidental thereto.
- F) Bidder does not consider that any further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data, are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of Work at prices or times specified herein.
- G) Bidder is aware of the general nature of the Work to be performed by the Owner or others at the Site, if any, that relates to the Work.
- H) Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, and other Data identified in the Bidding Documents.
- I) Bidder has given Owner written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Owner is acceptable to Bidder.
- J) The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.

- K) Bidder is aware that Owner may add, delete or change quantities of project components represented herein and that no adjustment in unit quantity cost shall be considered relative to change in unit quantities.
- L) Bidder will follow Connecticut State Law which mandates that Contractor's safety procedures include notifying "Call Before You Dig" in advance of excavation. The telephone number is 1-800-922-4455.
- 3.02 The person, or persons, undertaking the execution of the work under these specifications are herein designated as the "Contractor".
- 3.03 Should the specifications appear contradictory in any particulars, or should there be apparent errors, the Contractor shall refer the matter to the town for explanation or correction and shall abide by the decision.
- 3.04 The Contractor is to keep a competent superintendent on the work site at all times during construction, and is to provide all transportation, materials, labor, tools, equipment, etc., needed to perform the work in the best manner according to the specifications.
- 3.05 All material is to be of high quality. Should the Contractor introduce any material different from the sort of quality herein described or reasonably implied in the specifications, it shall be immediately removed if so ordered at any time during the progress of the work.
- 3.06 The Contractor is to comply with all Town Ordinances; give requisite notice to the proper authorities relating to the work; obtain all official permits and pay all proper fees for same, and answer for all damage or injury caused to neighboring premises or to the person or property of the public by himself or anyone in the Contractor's employ.
- 3.07 The Contractor, while the work progresses, shall keep the premises in a clean and tidy condition free from all unnecessary rubbish
- 3.08 If the Contractor claims that any instructions given him involve extra cost or extension of time, he shall, within five (5) days after receipt of such instructions, and in any event before proceeding to execute the work, submit his protest in writing to the Town of Darien stating clearly and in detail the basis of his objection. No such claim shall be valid unless so made.
- 3.09 The Town of Darien is exempt from the payment of taxes imposed by the Federal Government and the State of CT. Such taxes should not be included in the bid.
- 3.10 The Contractor shall provide, erect, and maintain all necessary precautions for the protection of the work and the safety of the public, including all signs, barricades and other traffic control devices required by Part VI of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- 3.11 After the award of the bid but prior to beginning the work, the contractor shall supply a payment and performance bond in at least one hundred percent of the total bid amount on forms provided by town.
- 4.01 Bidder further represents that this Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation; Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid; Bidder has not solicited or induced

- any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and, Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over other Bidder or over Owner.
- 4.02 The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder as determined by the Town. Lowest bid will be determined by the sum total of all extended costs. Bid alternates will not be used to determine the low bid.
- 5.01 A) Bidder will perform the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the price entered in the Schedule of Bid Items which follows. Some Bid Items are more fully defined in the construction drawings.
- B) Bidder acknowledges that Bidder's price(s) constitute Bidder's sole compensation for performing all Work required by the Contract Documents, and if a particular part of the Work is not listed in the Bid Item Descriptions, Bidder has included that part of the Work in the Bid Item Description which it most logically belongs.
- C) Unit Prices have been computed in accordance with paragraph 11.03 of the Standard General Conditions of the Construction Contract. Bidder acknowledges that quantities are not guaranteed and final payment will be based on actual quantities determined as provided in the Contract Documents.
- D) For contract value changes, regardless of the method used, the Contractor is required to submit evidence for any change in the contract price, satisfactory to the DPW, substantiating each item that constitutes his proposed value of the change.
- E) The amount allowed for overhead and profit shall not exceed the applicable percentages established in the following paragraph.
- For work done directly by the Contractor, a maximum overhead and profit in an amount of 15% is to be used. When work is done by a subcontractor the total overhead and profit is a maximum of 20% including both the Contractor and Subcontractor.
- F) The Contractor shall only work between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. The Contractor shall not perform work during holidays celebrated by the Town of Darien. There shall be no deviation of the above work hours without specific approval from the Director of Public Works.
- G) Bid alternates will not be used to determine the Low Bidder. All, some or none of the Bid Alternatives will be implemented in no particular order.**
- 6.01 Bidder agrees that the Work will be Substantially completed and ready for final payment in accordance with paragraph 14.07.B of the Standard General Conditions of the Construction Contract on or before the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement and Instruction to Bidders.
- 6.02 Bidder accepts the provisions for liquidated damages, if any, in the event of failure to complete the Work by the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement.

- 7.01 Bidder and its surety, where appropriate, have completed and executed the required Bid security which are attached to and made a condition of this Bid.
- 8.01 The terms used in this Bid with initial capital letters have the meanings indicated in the Instructions to Bidders, The Standard General Conditions of the Construction Contract, and the Supplementary Conditions.
- 9.01 Prevailing Wage Rates are required for this project as the bids total greater than \$100,000.**
- 9.02 The minimum wage rates, health, welfare and pension fund contributions are as determined by the State of Connecticut in accordance with the provisions of Section 31-53/31-54 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Contractor is responsible for all documentation required of him.
- 9.03 The minimum current wage and benefit rates are set forth in the wage schedule. The Contractor is bound and obligated by the Laws of Connecticut to insure payment to all workers involved with construction of this said Project.
- 9.04 Certified payroll reports must be submitted to the town.
- 10.01 Technical specifications shall be supplemented by the State of Connecticut, Department of Transportation, Form 818 as if said specifications were incorporated herein. References made in these specifications will be to the above Form 818.

Special Conditions @ Great Island – Delivery Site:

- All delivered material shall be placed at the location set by the drawing in the bid documents or as directed by the town.
- The contractor is responsible to keep the area and driveway clean and free of debris.
- Soil Erosion controls as shown on the plan are the responsibility of the contractor to install and maintain.
- If DPW has to perform any work related to this property that is associated with the contractor not performing his duties in accordance with the contract, then the contractor will be back charged for services rendered.
- All unacceptable material shall be disposed of at the contractor's expense.
- All deliveries shall be quantified prior to disposal at the site.

Special Permits:

- The contractor shall be responsible to ensure that all permits have been obtained. The DPW will work with the contractor to ensure all documents and permits are obtained. Any fees related to permits will be paid for by the Town of Darien DPW.
