ADDENDUM #2

The Original Bid Documents, including the Contract Documents, Specifications and Plans, are hereby amended as noted in this Addendum No. 2, dated April 15, 2026. Contractor shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum by inserting its number and date in the space provided in the Bid Documents.

1. *Question: Can the bridge be painted in place with decking / containment? Note 1 on sheet 2 states that the entire steel walkway is to be removed and painted off site. We believe there would be significant cost savings to painting in place.*

Answer: No painting in place.

2. *Question: If removal is required, can the power lines be deenergized? Can we remove the existing trees to facilitate the crane pick that would be required to lift the bridge over the power lines?*

Answer: Power line operation is the GC responsibility. GC must obtain permission by Town officials based on crane and equipment the GC needs to remove structural elements requiring removal.

3. *Question: Has lead testing been conducted on the existing steel, are there any deleading requirements?*

Answer: No lead testing has been completed along the existing steel members.
