Subject: Bid Express Changes - Enhanced Bidding Workflows

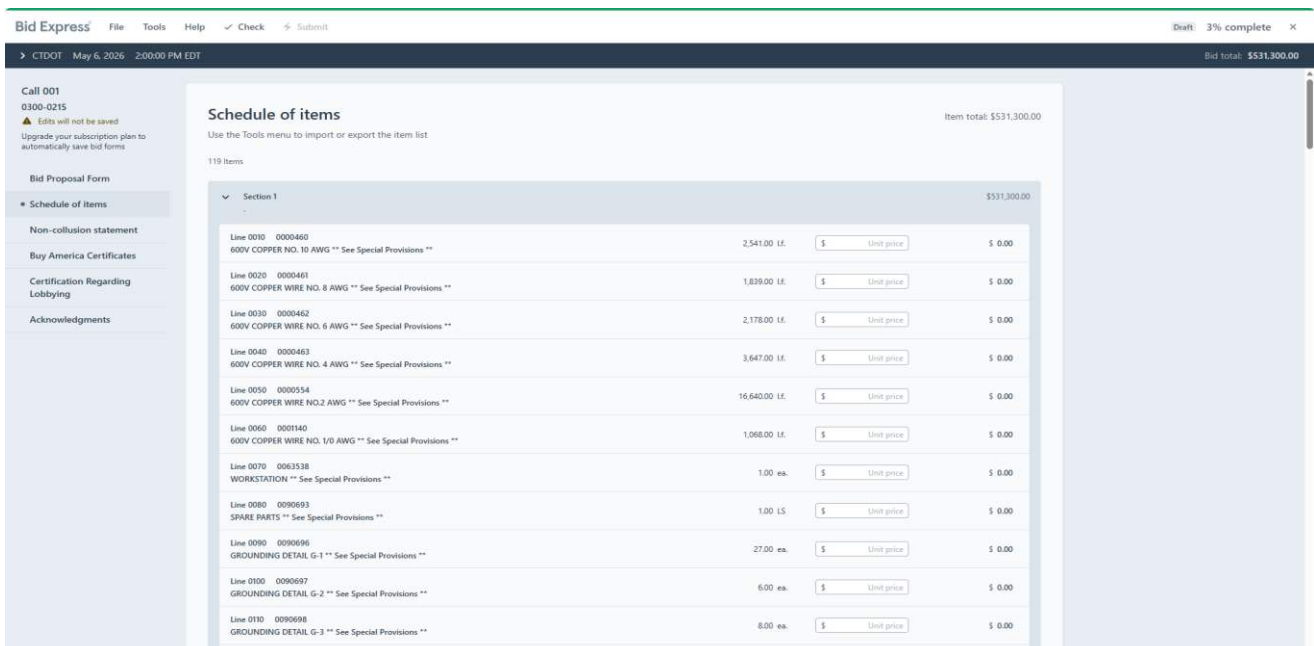
NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS:

The following are more details on the enhanced bidding workflows on Bidx.com that will be in place for May 6, 2026, projects advertised on April 8, 2026. For any project advertised prior to April 8, 2026, but the letting date gets postponed beyond April 29, 2026, it will require the bidder to submit their bid proposal in the enhanced (new) format.

These changes will significantly enhance your bidding process, offering a more efficient and user-friendly experience for all, a major step forward in modernizing our bidding process.

Key Benefits & New Features:

- **No More Installed Software:** Bid from any modern computer, including Macs.
- **Familiar Forms, Enhanced Experience:** The bid forms at Bidx.com will feel familiar but are now more efficient and accessible directly in your browser.
- **Intuitive Error Checking:** The new "Check Bid" feature guides you to any errors, helping you correct them quickly.

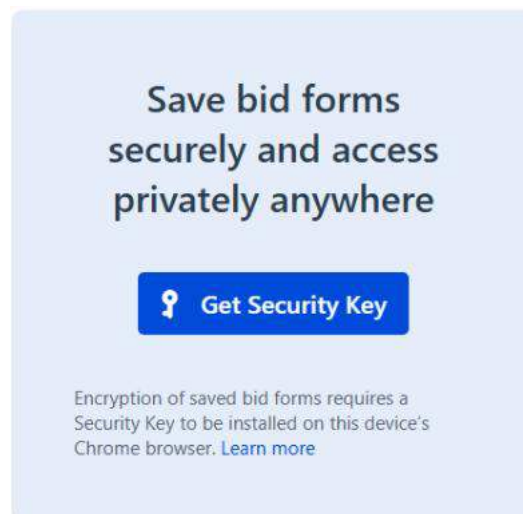


Sample browser-based bid form

What You Need to Do:

To ensure a smooth transition, please take a moment to understand the updated requirements:

- **Digital ID:** Existing Digital ID holders will be prompted to import their Infotech® Digital ID into their browser. **(starting with April 8, 2026, advertising)**
- **New Security Key:** The first time you open a proposal in the new experience, a "security key" will be created. This key serves as a crucial backup to your Digital ID.
